As executive director, she is responsible for the operation and management of apprenticeship. preapprenticeship and construction wireman/construction electrician (CW/CE) training and advancement programs. Williams oversees the training with an administrative assistant, a full-time instructor and many part-time instructors. She is a change management leader in the electrical apprenticeship industry, and the program has tripled in size under her direction. Williams gives credit of the growth to her committee who gives her the leeway for creative recruiting, promotion of the tuition-free credible training programs, excellent curriculum, community involvement, implementing best practices and 20+ years of strategic planning and management experience. She provides training to over 1,000 union electrical workers in North and South Carolina as well as northeast Georgia.
